James Hutchinson, M.D. practices psychoanalysis and intensive psychotherapy for adults and Adolescents. He is Medical Director, Avery Road Combined Care, a long term residential program for patient's suffering from a combination of major mental illness and longstanding substance abuse. Dr. Hutchinson graduated from the University of Rochester School of Medicine in 1971 and trained in adult psychoanalysis (1986) and adolescent and child psychoanalysis (1993) at the Baltimore Washington Institute for Psychoanalysis.
